2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 450

2017 Assembly Bill 450 authorizes a person who holds a Class "B" or "Class B" license or permit for the sale of beer or intoxicating liquor to also sell alcohol beverages at specific locations within the Ozaukee County fairgrounds during special events held at the fairgrounds, if both of the following criteria apply:

- The licensee's or permittee's premises are located in Ozaukee County.
- The Ozaukee County Board adopts a resolution approving the licensee or permittee.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 specifies that beer and intoxicating liquor sold at specific locations within the Ozaukee County fairgrounds pursuant to the bill must be sold for consumption at the specific locations within the fairgrounds.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Robert Brooks offered Assembly Amendment 1 on September 13, 2017. On September 20, 2017, the Assembly Committee on State Affairs voted to recommend the adoption of the amendment and the passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 13; Noes, 0.
