2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 670

2017 Assembly Bill 670 allows an exemption to continuing education requirements for individuals who are 65 years or older, have practiced for 30 or more years, and hold a credential granted by the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers, and Professional Land Surveyors (Board). Under the exemption, such individuals may continue using the professional title, but may not continue actively practicing in the profession.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 authorizes the Board to promulgate emergency rules to implement the Act, and specifies that the Act takes effect 10 months after publication rather than on the date after publication.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Kooyenga on January 17, 2018. On February 1, 2018, the Assembly Committee on Regulatory Licensing Reform unanimously recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of 2017 Assembly Bill 670, as amended.
