2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 740

Generally, current law requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to charge a \$62 fee, as well as a \$7.50 supplemental title fee, for a certificate of title after title to a vehicle has transferred to a new owner. However, current law requires DOT to waive the \$7.50 supplemental title fee when a decedent's interest in a vehicle is transferred to his or her surviving spouse or domestic partner.

Assembly Bill 740 requires DOT to waive the \$62 fee when a decedent's interest in a vehicle is transferred to the decedent's surviving spouse.

ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 requires DOT to waive the \$62 fee when a decedent's interest in a vehicle is transferred to the decedent's surviving spouse or domestic partner.

BILL HISTORY

Representative Pope offered Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 on January 22, 2018. On February 1, 2018, the Assembly Committee on Family Law recommended adoption of Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 on a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0; and passage of Assembly Bill 740, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 7; Noes, 0.
