2017 SENATE BILL 435

2017 Senate Bill 435 allows an emergency medical technician or a first responder to render first aid services to a sick or injured domestic animal, in certain cases.

SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 harmonizes the terminology used in the bill with that in 2017 Wisconsin Act 12, including the terms “emergency medical responder,” “emergency medical technician,” “emergency medical technician - intermediate,” “advanced emergency medical technician,” and “paramedic” to refer to individual provider levels, and the umbrella term “emergency medical services practitioners” to refer to various emergency service providers.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Cowles offered Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 2017 Senate Bill 435 on January 19, 2018. On January 23, 2018, the Senate voted to adopt Substitute Amendment 1 and pass Senate Bill 435, as amended.
