2017 SENATE BILL 630

Generally, current law requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to charge a \$62 fee, as well as a \$7.50 supplemental title fee, for a certificate of title after title to a vehicle has transferred to a new owner. However, current law requires DOT to waive the \$7.50 supplemental title fee when a decedent's interest in a vehicle is transferred to his or her surviving spouse or domestic partner.

Senate Bill 630 requires DOT to waive the \$62 fee when a decedent's interest in a vehicle is transferred to the decedent's surviving spouse.

SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Substitute Amendment 1 requires DOT to waive the \$62 fee when a decedent's interest in a vehicle is transferred to the decedent's surviving spouse or domestic partner.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Wanggaard offered Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to 2017 Senate Bill 630 on February 5, 2018. On February 6, 2018, the Senate Committee on Transportation and Veterans Affairs voted unanimously to recommend adoption of the substitute amendment and passage of the bill, as amended.
