2017 SENATE BILL 751

2017 Senate Bill 751 makes various changes related to the regulation of occupations and buildings and safety, as administered by the Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS) and the professional credentialing boards it houses.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 generally prohibits local governments from regulating tattooing and body piercing, unless authority is delegated by DSPS. It also changes the credential renewal date for physicians with a degree of doctor of osteopathy from March 1 of each even-numbered year to November 1 of each odd-numbered year.

BILL HISTORY

Senator Kapenga offered Senate Amendment 1 on February 23, 2018. On March 1, 2018, the Senate Committee on Public Benefits, Licensing, and State-Federal Relations unanimously recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of the bill, as amended.
