



1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 1094

March 28, 1996 – Introduced by Representatives SERATTI, MURAT and HASENOHRL.
Referred to Committee on Highways and Transportation.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** construction of a CTH “HH” bridge in Portage County and
2 making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of transportation (DOT) administers a program to fund local bridge construction and reconstruction. This bill provides \$7,015,500 in state funds for construction of a CTH “HH” bridge across the Wisconsin River in Portage County. The bill also permits DOT to reimburse Portage County for 75% of the preliminary engineering costs relating to this bridge that are incurred by Portage County.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) (a) From the appropriation under section 20.395 (2) (aq) of the statutes, the
5 department of transportation shall pay 75% of the preliminary engineering costs
6 relating to a CTH “HH” bridge project in Portage County. Notwithstanding section
7 84.11 of the statutes, the department may reimburse Portage County, for
8 preliminary engineering costs incurred by the county, to comply with this paragraph.

9 (b) This subsection does not apply after June 30, 1998.
