1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 168

- 1 AN ACT to create 29.174 (2) (g) of the statutes; relating to: fishing seasons for
- 2 certain persons and granting rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) establishes fishing seasons by rule. This bill specifically authorizes DNR to establish fishing seasons, in urban areas, that allow fishing only by persons who are under 16 years old or who are disabled and receive social security, supplemental security income or other types of federal disability benefits.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 29.174 (2) (g) of the statutes is created to read:
- 29.174 (2) (g) The department may establish a fishing season in certain urban areas, as determined by rule by the department, that allows fishing only by persons who are under 16 years old or who are disabled and can produce the evidence specified in s. 29.145 (1c) (b) or the evidence specified in s. 29.145 (1c) (c).
