## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 169

March 2, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives Linton, R. Potter, Boyle, Wirch, Robson, Seratti and Hasenohrl, cosponsored by Senators Jauch, Andrea and Breske. Referred to Committee on Veterans and Military Affairs.

AN ACT *to amend* 45.37 (3) (b) of the statutes; **relating to:** eligibility for membership in the Wisconsin Veterans Home.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law restricts eligibility for membership in the Wisconsin Veterans Home to certain veterans. The veteran must be a resident of this state at the time of admission to the home. The veteran must have been a resident of this state at the time that he or she entered service, or he or she must have been a resident of this state for the 10 years preceding the date of application for membership in the home. This bill changes the 10-year residency requirement to 5 years preceding the date of application for membership.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 45.37 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 45.37 (3) (b) *Nonresident*. A veteran who was not a resident of this state at the time of enlistment or induction into service but who is otherwise qualified for membership may be admitted if the veteran has been a resident of this state for the 10 5 years next preceding the date of application.
  - Section 2. Initial applicability.
