Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides a process for a school district to adopt a management restructuring program. Under the statutory procedure, the program had to be implemented beginning in the 1994–95 school year. This bill eliminates from the statutes the procedure for adopting a management restructuring program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 SECTION 1. 20.255 (2) (ds) of the statutes is repealed.
- 4 **SECTION 2.** 118.013 of the statutes is repealed.
