## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 214

March 17, 1995 - Introduced by Representatives Coleman, Ward, Handrick, HOVEN, JENSEN, GROBSCHMIDT, HAHN, PLACHE, SCHNEIDERS, GROTHMAN, RYBA, Duff, Ainsworth, Nass, Robson, Dobyns, Foti, Harsdorf, Musser, Vrakas, LEHMAN, KREIBICH, GOETSCH and GUNDERSON, cosponsored by Senators Petak, PANZER and HUELSMAN. Referred to Committee on Education.

AN ACT to repeal 118.24 (2) (e) of the statutes; relating to: the attendance of school district administrators at an annual convention called by the state superintendent of public instruction.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires each school district administrator to attend annually one convention called by the state superintendent of public instruction for the purpose of consultation upon matters pertaining to the supervision and management of the schools. This bill eliminates this requirement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **Section 1.** 118.24 (2) (e) of the statutes is repealed.
