AN ACT *to amend* 118.145 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:** requirements for admission to high school.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, with certain exceptions the school board of a school district operating high school grades (grades 9 to 12) determines, with the advice and consent of the state superintendent of public instruction, the minimum standards for admission to high school.

This bill eliminates the requirement for state superintendent advice and consent.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 118.145 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 118.145 (1) The school board of a district operating high school grades shall
- 5 determine, with the advice and consent of the state superintendent, the minimum
- 6 standards for admission to high school.
