## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 387

May 23, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives Boyle, Baldus, Krug, L. Young, Cullen, Hasenohrl, La Fave, Bell, Robson, Kreuser and Riley, cosponsored by Senators Decker, Andrea and Moen. Referred to Committee on Mandates.

AN ACT *to create* 115.343 (6) of the statutes; **relating to:** the use in schools of milk produced by herds administered synthetic bovine growth hormone.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs each school board to ensure that, beginning July 1, 1996, milk produced from herds being administered synthetic bovine growth hormone is not served in any public school.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 115.343 (6) of the statutes is created to read:
- 115.343 (6) Beginning July 1, 1996, the school board shall ensure that milk produced from herds being administered synthetic bovine growth hormone is not served in any public school.
