1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 395

May 24, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives Meyer, Baldus, Boyle, Kelso and Ryba, cosponsored by Senators Rude, Andrea and C. Potter. Referred to Committee on Highways and Transportation.

AN ACT *to create* 341.05 (19m) of the statutes; **relating to:** exempting from vehicle registration certain vehicles owned by a technical college district board and used for educational purposes.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a person may not drive a vehicle upon a highway in this state unless the vehicle is registered with the department of transportation or is exempt from registration.

This bill exempts from registration a vehicle that is owned by a technical college district board and used for educational purposes if the vehicle is driven within 5 miles of the technical college to transport the vehicle to or from the technical college.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 341.05 (19m) of the statutes is created to read:
- 341.05 (19m) Is owned by a technical college district board, used for educational purposes and is operated only within 5 miles of the technical college to transport the vehicle to or from a technical college.
