June 26, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives Grothman, Ainsworth, Brandemuehl, Duff, Hahn, F. Lasee, Lehman, Nass, Olsen, Schneiders, Seratti, Silbaugh, Skindrud and Ziegelbauer, cosponsored by Senators Panzer and Schultz, by request of Washington County Library Board. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

1 AN ACT to amend 43.57 (4) (c) of the statutes; relating to: the membership of

a county library board.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county board may establish a consolidated county library to serve the residents of the county who do not live in municipalities that have libraries and to improve the library services of municipal libraries. Currently, the county board chairperson, with the approval of the county board, appoints a county library board to govern the consolidated county library. A county library board must include, among other members, a school district administrator of a school district located in whole or in part in the county. This bill permits a county library board to include the designee of a school district administrator of a school district located wholly or in part in the county.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	SECTION 1. 43.57 (4) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	43.57 (4) (c) Boards appointed under pars. (a) and (b) shall include at least one
5	school district administrator of a school district located in whole or in part in the
6	county, or that school district administrator's designee, and one or 2 county board
7	supervisors. Boards appointed under par. (b) shall include, in addition,

representatives of existing library boards under s. 43.54 and persons residing in
municipalities not served by libraries.
