1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 529

September 1, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives R. Young, Kaufert, Krug, Seratti, Plombon, Boyle, Notestein and Baldwin, cosponsored by Senators Buettner, Burke, Farrow and Clausing. Referred to Joint survey committee on Retirement Systems.

AN ACT **relating to:** access to Wisconsin retirement system pensions for court-ordered support purposes.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the department of employe trust funds and the department of health and social services to submit a report to the secretary of administration by December 1, 1995, proposing the most cost-effective way to allow a person's benefits under the Wisconsin retirement system to be assigned to another person pursuant to a court order regarding certain child or family support payments.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) Assignment of Benefits report. The department of employe trust funds and the department of health and social services shall jointly submit a report to the secretary of administration by December 1, 1995, proposing the most cost-effective way to allow a person's benefits under the Wisconsin retirement system to be assigned to another person pursuant to a court order under section 767.265 of the statutes.
