- 1 AN ACT to amend 347.25 (1s) of the statutes; relating to: permitting the use of
- 2 a green light on fire department command post vehicles.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a fire department command post vehicle at an emergency call site may be equipped with a blue light that is flashing, oscillating or rotating. This bill permits such vehicles to be equipped with a blue or green light that is flashing, oscillating or rotating.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 347.25 (1s) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 347.25 (1s) A vehicle in use by a fire department as a command post at the site
- of an emergency call may be equipped with a blue <u>or green</u> light which is flashing,
- 6 oscillating or rotating.
