

## **1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 574**

September 25, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives FREESE, WALKER, AINSWORTH, ALBERS, GROTHMAN, HOVEN, KREIBICH, F. LASEE, OTT, OTTE, SKINDRUD, VRAKAS and ZUKOWSKI, cosponsored by Senators SCHULTZ and FITZGERALD. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Corrections.

1 AN ACT to create 302.085 of the statutes; relating to: the use of weights or

body-building or weight-training equipment in state prisons.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides various restrictions on activities within state prisons. This bill prohibits the use, by inmates, guards or others, of equipment or weights for body building or weight training in a state prison.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 302.085 of the statutes is created to read:

## 4 **302.085 Restrictions on the use of certain equipment.** The warden or

- 5 superintendent of a Type 1 prison shall not allow inmates, correctional officers or
- 6 other persons to use any machine, equipment, apparatus or weights for body
- 7 strengthening or weight training in a Type 1 prison.
