- AN ACT to create 118.07 (3) of the statutes; relating to: the size of pole vault
- 2 landing pads used by public school pupils.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current rules adopted by the National Federation of State High School Associations (and adhered to by the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association), pole vault landing pads must be at least 16 feet wide and 12 feet deep. This bill requires that, effective July 1, 1997, pole vault landing pads used by public school pupils must be at least 21 feet 6 inches wide and 24 feet deep.

- 3 **Section 1.** 118.07 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 118.07 (3) Each school board shall ensure that the pole vault landing pads used
- by public school pupils are at least 21 feet 6 inches wide and 24 feet deep.
 - Section 2. Effective date.
