1 AN ACT to create 23.28 (4) of the statutes; relating to: a snowmobile trail

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of natural resources (DNR) may not permit the use of a state natural area if the use is inconsistent with or injurious to the area's natural values. Under this bill, DNR may permit the establishment of a snowmobile trail through the Squirrel River Pines State Natural Area.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 23.28 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 23.28 (4) SNOWMOBILE TRAIL. Notwithstanding sub. (3), the department may
- 5 permit the establishment of a snowmobile trail through the Squirrel River Pines
- 6 State Natural Area.
