1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 749

December 19, 1995 – Introduced by Representatives Kelso, Grothman, BRANDEMUEHL, AINSWORTH, LADWIG, OTT, SCHNEIDERS, SKINDRUD, GOETSCH, OLSEN, ZUKOWSKI and RILEY, cosponsored by Senators DRZEWIECKI and SCHULTZ. Referred to Committee on Urban and Local Affairs.

1 AN ACT to create 174.046 (10) of the statutes; relating to: the destruction of dogs

that have contagious diseases or are suffering.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, if a stray dog has been in the custody of a humane officer, law enforcement officer or pound for more than 7 days without being claimed by the owner, the officer or pound may release the dog to a person other than the owner or destroy the dog. Under this bill, a humane officer, law enforcement officer or pound to whom a dog is delivered may, with the approval of a veterinarian, destroy the dog sooner than 7 days after receiving the dog if the dog has a contagious disease or is suffering.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 174.046 (10) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 174.046 (10) DISEASED OR INJURED DOG. Notwithstanding sub. (9), the officer or
- 5 pound to whom a dog is delivered may, with the approval of a veterinarian, destroy
- 6 the dog in a proper and humane manner sooner than 7 days after receiving the dog
- 7 if the dog has a contagious disease or is suffering.
