1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 846

February 5, 1996 – Introduced by Representatives JENSEN, DUFF, OTTE, KREUSER and HOVEN, cosponsored by Senator ANDREA. Referred to Committee on Environment and Utilities.

1 AN ACT to amend 144.42 (5) (b) of the statutes; relating to: motor vehicles

subject to emission limitations and emission inspection.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires the department of transportation to conduct a motor vehicle emission inspection program in counties in which the air quality does not meet certain federal standards. Under the program, motor vehicles that are subject to emission limitations established by the department of natural resources must be inspected. Certain motor vehicles are exempt from the emission limitations and, thus, are not required to be inspected. Under current law, motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of over 14,000 pounds are exempt from the emission limitations and the inspection program.

This bill lowers the weight over which a motor vehicle is exempted from motor vehicle emission limitations and the motor vehicle emission inspection program from 14,000 pounds to 8,500 pounds.

- 4 is amended to read:
