



## 1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 886

February 13, 1996 - Introduced by Representatives PLOMBON, WILDER, TURNER, BALDUS, CULLEN, REYNOLDS, BELL, GRONEMUS and HASENOHRL, cosponsored by Senator MOEN. Referred to Committee on Education.

1     **AN ACT to create** 20.255 (2) (ae) and 121.082 of the statutes; **relating to:**  
2             distribution of additional school aid to certain school districts and making an  
3             appropriation.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill makes additional state school aid available to school districts in which both of the following occur: 1) in the previous school year, the net cost of the school district's general fund divided by the school district's student membership is less than 92% of the statewide average; and 2) in the previous school year, the equalized value of the school district (that is, the full value of the taxable property in the territory of the school district) divided by the school district's student membership was less than the statewide average. Under the bill, the state is required to pay an eligible school district the amount necessary to ensure that the net cost of the school district's general fund divided by the school district's student membership is equal to 92% of the statewide average.
