1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 10

Relating to: providing for an advisory referendum on the question of enacting the death penalty in this state.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution calls for an advisory referendum at the spring election in April 1995 on the question of enacting the death penalty in the state of Wisconsin for certain types of first-degree intentional homicide, as the legislature may prescribe by law.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That there be submitted, for advisory purposes only, to the voters of this state at the spring election to be held in April 1995, the following question:

"Shall the death penalty be enacted in the State of Wisconsin for certain types of first-degree intentional homicide as the legislature may prescribe by law?"
