1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 102

May 7, 1996 - Introduced by Committee on Assembly Organization. Referred to Calendar.

Relating to: providing for an advisory referendum on the question of the state continuing to provide property tax relief by paying for two-thirds of local school costs, on average, without raising sales or income taxes.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution calls for an advisory referendum at the general election in November 1996 on the question of the state continuing to provide property tax relief by paying for two-thirds of local school costs, on average, without raising sales or income taxes.

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That there is submitted to the voters of this state at the November 1996 general election, for advisory purposes only, the following question:

QUESTION 1: "State payment of two-thirds of local school costs. Last year, the state legislature voted to reduce state government to help provide \$1.2 billion in property tax relief by paying two-thirds of local school costs. Should the state continue to provide property tax relief by paying for two-thirds of local school costs, on average, without raising sales or income taxes?"
