1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 103

May 7, 1996 – Introduced by Committee on Assembly Organization. Referred to Calendar.

Relating to: providing for an advisory referendum on the question of whether a
two-thirds vote of both houses of the legislature should be required in order to
pass legislation increasing state income tax rates or state sales tax rates.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This joint resolution calls for an advisory referendum at the general election in November 1996 on whether a two-thirds vote of both houses of the legislature should be required in order to pass legislation increasing state income tax rates or state sales tax rates.

7	QUESTION 1: "Vote required to increase state income or sales tax rates.
8	Should a two-thirds vote of both houses of the legislature be required in order to pass
9	legislation increasing state income tax rates or state sales tax rates?"
