1	Relating to: requesting Congress and the federal Secretary of Agriculture, Daniel
2	Glickman, to revise the milk marketing system.
3	Whereas, the current national milk marketing and dairy price support system
4	is antiquated and disconnected from economic reality; and
5	Whereas, the entire system continues to turn on the price of manufacturing
6	milk in the upper Midwest and the distance of any particular market from Eau
7	Claire, Wisconsin; and
8	Whereas, this system places Wisconsin's dairy farmers at a comparative
9	disadvantage compared to other milk-producing areas of the nation and sends
10	wrong signals to milk-producing areas of the country, especially when considering
11	their agricultural infrastructure and inherent suitability for the production of milk,
12	to the disadvantage of Wisconsin dairy farmers; and
13	Whereas, the impending 1995 federal farm bill will present an opportunity to
14	right the inherent injustices of the current system by reconnecting it to market and
15	economic forces; now, therefore, be it
16	Resolved by the assembly, the Senate concurring, That the members of the

Wisconsin legislature request Congress and Secretary of Agriculture Daniel

Glickman to fundamentally revise the milk marketing and dairy price support
 system in 1995; and, be it further

Resolved, That that the assembly chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint
resolution to each member of this state's congressional delegation and to Secretary
Glickman.
