

1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 2

January 4, 1995 – Introduced by Representative Ourada, cosponsored by Senator Breske.

1	Relating to: the life and public service of Fred Reger.
2	Whereas, Fred Reger was born on April 14, 1916, in Clare, Michigan, and died
3	on September 12, 1994, in Merrill; and
4	Whereas, he was a graduate of Merrill High School and Lincoln County
5	Teachers College; and
6	Whereas, he was the mayor of Merrill from 1946 to 1948, a member of the
7	Merrill City Council and the Lincoln County Board and a member of the Lincoln
8	County Teachers College Board; and
9	Whereas, he was elected to the assembly in 1962 and served during the 1963-64
10	session on the Taxation Committee, the Education Committee and the Legislative
11	Council Election Laws Committee; and
12	Whereas, Mr. Reger was also an insurance agent and a grade school teacher;
13	now, therefore, be it
14	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the
15	legislature of the state of Wisconsin salute the many years of public service that Fred
16	Reger rendered in a number of positions, express their sorrow at his death and
17	extend their condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further

Resolved, That the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
resolution to Mr. Reger's wife, Ena, and to his daughters, Gayla Reger and Ellen
Reger.
