Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The legislative reference bureau (LRB) is directed by statute to prepare in plain language an analysis of each original measure. This joint resolution directs the LRB also to prepare in plain language an analysis of each substitute amendment, if time permits.

Resolved by the assembly, the Senate concurring, That:

- 4 **Section 1.** Joint rule 51 is renumbered joint rule 50.
- **Section 2.** Joint rule 51 is created to read:
 - Joint Rule 51. **Analyses on substitute amendments.** The legislative reference bureau, if time permits, shall prepare in plain language an analysis of each substitute amendment, to be reproduced with the substitute amendment when it is introduced.
