

1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 66

November 8, 1995 – Introduced by Representative Cullen, cosponsored by Senator George.

1	Relating to: the life and public service of Steve Cullen.
2	Whereas, Steve Cullen was born on January 5, 1955, in Evanston, Illinois, and
3	died on October 12, 1995, in Cincinnati, Ohio; and
4	Whereas, he graduated from Milwaukee Washington High School and the
5	University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee; and
6	Whereas, he was elected to the Milwaukee Common Council in 1980 and
7	reelected in 1984 and 1988; and
8	Whereas, he served on many committees and boards, including the MECCA
9	Board, and as chairman of the Common Council Finance and Personnel Committee;

11	Whereas, his tenure was marked by many accomplishments; such as the
12	drafting, selecting and awarding of the first cable television franchise,
13	reorganization of city government and leadership on the city budget; and
14	Whereas, Steve is survived by his wife, Gael, and their 4 beautiful daughters;
15	Annie, Kathleen, Molly and Colleen; as well as his mother, Beatrice, and 5 brothers
16	and sisters; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the members of the legislature of the state of Wisconsin commend the years of devoted public service that Steve Cullen performed for this state and the city of Milwaukee, express their sorrow at his death and extend their condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further Resolved, That the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint resolution to Steve Cullen's wife, Gael Garbarino Cullen, and to his daughters; Annie, Kathleen, Molly and Colleen.
