



## 1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 73

January 16, 1996 - Introduced by Representatives KELSO, GREEN, RYBA, F. LASEE, HUTCHISON, LORGE and GARD, cosponsored by Senators DRZEWIECKI, COWLES and A. LASEE. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1       **Relating to:** commending the 1995 Green Bay Packers.

2               Whereas, the 1995 Green Bay Packers won the central division of the National  
3       Football Conference; and

4               Whereas, the Packers then defeated the Atlanta Falcons and the Super Bowl  
5       Champion San Francisco Forty-niners in the playoffs, advancing farther than any  
6       Packer team since the 1967 world champions; and

7               Whereas, these accomplishments proved correct the thousands of loyal fans  
8       who have been saying for decades that “the Pack will be back”; and

9               Whereas, the Packers lost by the narrowest of margins to the Dallas Cowboys,  
10       and their remarkable season ended one game short of the Super Bowl; and

11              Whereas, the Packers accomplished these feats partly by creating rare  
12       combinations of intelligence and power; exuberance and discipline; and team play  
13       and individual brilliance; and

14              Whereas, this season was also memorable for such individual achievements as  
15       Brett Favre’s selection as the league’s most valuable player; Reggie White’s  
16       astounding recovery from a serious injury and his selection, along with Brett Favre  
17       and Mark Chmura, to the Pro Bowl team; and Robert Brooks’s spectacular play; and
