

## **1995 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 94**

March 26, 1996 – Introduced by Representatives HANSON, R. YOUNG, BLACK, BALDWIN, TRAVIS, HAHN, SKINDRUD and SILBAUGH, cosponsored by Senators RISSER, CHVALA and WINEKE. Referred to calendar.

1	Relating to: commending the 1995 University of Wisconsin-Madison women's
2	basketball team.
3	Whereas, the 1995–96 University of Wisconsin–Madison women's basketball
4	team had their best season in the programs history, finishing with a 21–8 record, and
5	set a school record with 10 wins in a row; and
6	Whereas, the Badger women, for the first time ever, cracked the Associated
7	Press Top Ten poll, with a ranking of 8th on February 5; and
8	Whereas, the fans have shown their strong support for the Badger women
9	through their record-setting attendance with an average of 7,884 per game, which
10	was first in the Big Ten and 4th in the nation; and
11	Whereas, Head Coach Jane Albright-Dieterle brought her team to its 2nd
12	straight NCAA play-off; and
13	Whereas, the Badger women have many outstanding players; including Barb
14	Franke, who earned first team all–Big Ten honors, and Keisha Anderson, who was
15	named to the 2nd team for the 2nd straight year; now, therefore, be it
