3	Whereas, Shannon Faulkner attempted for 2 1/2 years to join the Citadel, the
4	South Carolina state military college; and
5	Whereas, Shannon Faulkner was the first woman cadet in the 152-year history
6	of the cadet corps; and
7	Whereas, Shannon Faulkner broke down barriers for women in the Citadel;

9	Whereas, the male students at the Citadel demonstrated demoralizing,
10	despicable and outrageous behavior against Shannon Faulkner; and
11	Whereas, the male students' intolerance of change and misguided attitudes
12	have made them a national spectacle of which America should be ashamed; and
13	Whereas, Shannon Faulkner, unlike her male counterparts, has proved herself
