May 7, 1996 – Introduced by Committee on Assembly Organization. Referred to Calendar.

1	Relating to: welcoming Chancellor Helmut Kohl to Wisconsin and wishing him well
2	during his visit.
3	Whereas, Chancellor Helmut Kohl has led West Germany since 1982 and,
4	under his dynamic leadership, the country has become increasingly influential in
5	world affairs and prospered economically; and
6	Whereas, Chancellor Kohl became leader of a reunited Germany in 1990 after
7	East German conservative parties supporting reunification were elected to power
8	and the Berlin Wall was dismantled in 1989; and
9	Whereas, under Chancellor Kohl's leadership, Germany has strengthened its
10	international trade alliance with the United States; and
11	Whereas, Chancellor Kohl will meet with President Clinton in Milwaukee, a
12	community rich in German heritage, on May 23, 1996, to discuss issues of interest
13	to Germany and the United States and to enhance the international ties between our
14	2 great nations; and
15	Whereas, Milwaukee is the American city most fitting and proper to welcome
16	Germany's leading citizen because of the profound, positive influences that Germany

has had on the city and on the State of Wisconsin; now, therefore, be it
