1 **To amend** assembly rule 39 (1); **relating to**: prohibiting the offering of assembly

2 proposals creating a state symbol.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This resolution prohibits a member or standing committee of the assembly from offering a proposal creating a state symbol.

3	Resolved by the assembly, That:
4	SECTION 1. Assembly rule 39 (1) is amended to read:
5	Assembly Rule 39 (1) Except as otherwise provided in joint rule 83 (2), any
6	member or standing committee may offer proposals for introduction in the assembly
7	on any day of the biennial legislative session <u>, except that a member or a standing</u>
8	committee may not offer a proposal creating a state symbol.
