4	SECTION 1. Assembly rule 39 (1) is amended to read:
5	Assembly Rule 39 (1) Except as otherwise provided in joint rule 83 (2), any
6	member or standing committee may offer proposals for introduction in the assembly
7	on any day of the biennial legislative session <u>, except that a member or standing</u>
8	<u>committee may not offer a proposal designating a day, week, month or year for</u>
9	observance.
