1995 SENATE BILL 103

March 8, 1995 – Introduced by Senator Petak, cosponsored by Representatives Plache, Ladwig, Baldus, Jensen, Musser, Grothman, Ainsworth, Kreibich and Olsen. Referred to Committee on Education and Financial Institutions.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 121.15 (1) (a), 121.15 (1) (c) and 121.15 (1) (e) of the statutes;
- 2 **relating to:** the school aid distribution schedule.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, each school district receives 15% of its total aid entitlement in September, 25% in December, 25% in March and 35% in June.

This bill provides that each school district receives one–sixth of its total aid entitlement in September, November, January, March, May and June.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 121.15 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 121.15 (1) (a) Each school district shall receive 15% one-sixth of its total aid
- 5 entitlement in September, 25% one-sixth of its total aid entitlement in December,
- 6 25% November, one-sixth of its total aid entitlement in January, one-sixth of its total
- 7 aid entitlement in March, one-sixth of its total aid entitlement in May and 35%
- 8 <u>one-sixth</u> of its total aid entitlement in June.
 - **SECTION 2.** 121.15 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

121.15 (1) (c) For the payments from December November to June, the total
aid entitlement for each district shall be computed on the basis of the budget and
membership report under s. 121.05.
Section 3. 121.15 (1) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:
121.15 (1) (e) Payments under this subsection shall be made on the first
Monday of the month for the December payment November, January and May
payments, on the 3rd Monday of the month for the September and June payments
and on the 4th Monday of the month for the March payment.
Section 4. Initial applicability.
(1) This act first applies to the distribution of state aid in the fiscal year
