1995 SENATE BILL 136

AN ACT relating to: repaying a portion of I 43 in Milwaukee County.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the department of transportation to repave a portion of I 43 in Milwaukee County to eliminate the tined surface.

For further information see the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Nonstatutory provisions; transportation.

(1) The department of transportation shall repave that portion of I 43 with a tined surface beginning before Henry Clay Street and extending beyond Bender and Devon streets in Milwaukee County, no later than 6 months after the effective date of this subsection, for the purpose of eliminating the tined surface. The department shall expend funds from the appropriation under section 20.395 (3) (cq) or (cx) of the statutes for the repaving project.
