- 1 AN ACT to amend 59.07 (27) of the statutes; relating to: membership in a county
- 2 board's association.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, a two-thirds vote of a county board is required for the board to purchase membership in an association of county boards. Under this bill, only a majority vote of the members-elect is needed to make such a purchase.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 **Section 1.** 59.07 (27) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 59.07 (27) COUNTY BOARDS' ASSOCIATION. By a two-thirds majority vote of the
- 5 <u>members-elect</u>, purchase membership in an association of county boards for the
- 6 protection of county interests and the furtherance of better county government.
