Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides an additional \$1,000,000 for the national guard tuition grant program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Appropriation changes.

4 (1) NATIONAL GUARD TUITION GRANTS. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3)

5 of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of military affairs under

- 6 section 20.465 (2) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1993 and 1995, the
- 7 dollar amount is increased by \$1,000,000 for fiscal year 1994-95 to provide
- 8 additional tuition grants to national guard members.
