## **1995 SENATE BILL 65**

February 14, 1995 – Introduced by Senators Clausing, Breske, Chvala, Moore, Burke and Jauch, cosponsored by Representatives Baldus, Baumgart, L. Young, Lorge, Wilder, Springer, Black, Hahn, Ryba, Carpenter, R. Young, Robson, Gronemus, Boyle and Hasenohrl. Referred to Committee on Education and Financial Institutions.

AN ACT to repeal 115.343 (4); and to amend 20.255 (2) (cp) of the statutes; relating to: the Wisconsin morning milk program and making an appropriation.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill changes the appropriation that funds the Wisconsin morning milk program from a sum certain to a sum sufficient.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 20.255 (2) (cp) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 5 20.255 (2) (cp) Wisconsin morning milk program. The amounts in the schedule
- 6 A sum sufficient for the Wisconsin morning milk program under s. 115.343.
- 7 **Section 2.** 115.343 (4) of the statutes is repealed.
