



## 1995 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 59

March 27, 1996 – Introduced by Senators SCHULTZ, WELCH, DARLING, DRZEWIECKI, PANZER, FITZGERALD, ZIEN, HUELSMAN, WEEDEN, PETAK, FARROW, BRESKE, RUDE, BUETTNER, COWLES, JAUCH, SHIBILSKI, WINEKE, C. POTTER, ANDREA and GROBSCHMIDT. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1     **Relating to:** expressing support for the Republic of China (Taiwan).

2             Whereas, the Republic of China (Taiwan) has had a special relationship with  
3     the people and state of Wisconsin for many years; and

4             Whereas, the Republic of China (Taiwan) is a paradigm of the success of a  
5     market-based economic system and a democratic political system; and

6             Whereas, in recent weeks, the People's Republic of China has been escalating  
7     its threatening rhetoric and propaganda directed at the Republic of China (Taiwan);  
8     and

9             Whereas, the people of Wisconsin are concerned with the security of the citizens  
10    and government of the Republic of China (Taiwan) and are supportive of its efforts  
11    to become a fully democratic nation; and

12            Whereas, it is the fervent hope and desire of the state of Wisconsin that the  
13    People's Republic of China will not interfere with the Republic of China's (Taiwan),  
14    continuing pursuit of a democratic political system, recognizing that the Republic of  
15    China (Taiwan) has successfully completed its first presidential election; now,
