## **1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 129**

February 18, 1997 – Introduced by Representatives SCHNEIDER, L. YOUNG, R. YOUNG and KREIBICH. Referred to Committee on Tourism and Recreation.

- 1 AN ACT to amend 30.62 (3) (a) of the statutes; relating to: wearing personal
- 2 flotation devices on boats.

#### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, each boat must have on it a personal flotation device for each person riding in or on the boat. Under this bill, each person riding in or on a boat must wear a personal flotation device.

# The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 30.62 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 30.62 (3) (a) Every boat, except <u>Except for riding on</u> a sailboard and except as
- 5 provided in par. (b), shall carry at least one <u>each person riding in or on a boat shall</u>
- 6 <u>wear a personal flotation device</u>, prescribed by federal regulations for each person
- 7 on board or being attended by the boat, so placed as to be readily accessible and
- 8 available to the persons, during the time the boat is being operated.
