1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 337

May 1, 1997 – Introduced by Representatives J. LEHMAN, PLOUFF, TURNER, BOCK and HASENOHRL, cosponsored by Senators PLACHE, DECKER, WINEKE and WIRCH. Referred to Committee on Mandates.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 118.01 (2) (c) 6. of the statutes; **relating to:** requiring 2 instruction in public schools on the history of organized labor in America and 3 the collective bargaining process.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that every school board's instructional program in state, national and world history include information on the history of organized labor in America and the collective bargaining process.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
