- 1 AN ACT to amend 77.52 (2) (a) 5. of the statutes; relating to: exempting certain
- 2 telecommunications services from the sales tax.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax exemption for telecommunications services that allow persons who have transmitters to communicate with a hospital when they need medical attention.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **Section 1.** 77.52 (2) (a) 5. of the statutes is amended to read:
- 77.52 (2) (a) 5. The sale of telecommunications services, not including services
  that allow persons who have transmitters to communicate with a hospital when they
  need medical attention, that originate in this state and are charged to a service
- address in this state, regardless of the location where that charge is billed or paid.
