

1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 477

August 19, 1997 – Introduced by Representatives SCHNEIDER, HASENOHRL, GOETSCH, GRONEMUS, TURNER and L. YOUNG. Referred to Committee on Colleges and Universities.

AN ACT to amend 36.25 (23) of the statutes; relating to: courses offered by the 1

Robert M. La Follette Institute of Public Affairs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that at least 80% of the courses offered by the Robert M. La Follette Institute of Public Affairs at the University of Wisconsin-Madison be held after 5 p.m.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3	SECTION 1. 36.25 (23) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	36.25 (23) ROBERT M. LA FOLLETTE INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS. There is
5	established a Robert M. La Follette institute of public affairs at the University of
6	Wisconsin-Madison. The institute shall engage in research, public service and
7	educational activities to advance the knowledge of public affairs and the application
8	of that knowledge to the needs of this state. <u>Beginning in the 1998–99 academic year</u> ,
9	at least 80% of the courses offered by the Institute shall be held after 5 p.m.
