## 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 687

December 30, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives Johnsrud, Musser, Grothman, Gronemus, Ourada, Zukowski, Schafer, Powers, Springer, Gunderson, Plouff and Ott, cosponsored by Senators Shibilski, Zien and Decker. Referred to Committee on Natural Resources.

AN ACT to repeal 29.227 (1) (b), 29.227 (2) (a) (title), 29.227 (2) (b) (title), 29.227 (2) (a) (title) and 29.227 (3) (b) (title); to renumber 29.227 (2) (a), 29.227 (2) (b) 1., 29.227 (2) (b) 2., 29.227 (3) (a), 29.227 (3) (b) (intro.), 29.227 (3) (b) 1., 29.227 (3) (b) 2. and 29.227 (3) (b) 3.; to renumber and amend 29.227 (2) (b) (intro.); to amend 29.227 (1) (title), 29.227 (2) (title), 29.227 (3) (title) and 29.227 (5); and to create 29.227 (3r) (title) of the statutes; relating to: possession of firearms by persons under 12 years of age.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a minor who is under 12 years old may not possess a firearm unless he or she is carrying the firearm to or from a hunter education and firearm safety program accompanied by his or her parent or guardian or unless he or she is using the firearm during the class. Under current law, a minor who is 12 or 13 years old may not possess a firearm unless he or she is accompanied by his or her parent or guardian or is enrolled in such a program and is either carrying the firearm to or from the class or is using it during the class. The bill eliminates the specific restrictions for minors under 12 years old so that the current restrictions that apply only to minors who are 12 or 13 years old apply to any minor 13 years old or younger.
