1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 719

- January 15, 1998 Introduced by Representatives Ryba, AINSWORTH, PLOUFF, KELSO, VANDER LOOP, GRONEMUS, MUSSER and GOETSCH, cosponsored by Senators DRZEWIECKI and ROESSLER. Referred to Committee on Government Operations.
- 1 AN ACT to amend 230.05 (8) of the statutes; relating to: training services 2 provided by the department of employment relations for nonstate 3 governmental units.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the administrator of the division of merit recruitment and selection in the department of employment relations is authorized to provide personnel testing services to nonstate governmental units, such as cities, counties, school districts and villages. This bill authorizes the administrator to provide *any* personnel services to nonstate governmental units, not just testing services.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.05 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.05 (8) The administrator may provide <u>any</u> personnel testing services to
nonstate governmental units and may charge for those the nonstate governmental
<u>units for providing the</u> services.
