## 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 821

February 24, 1998 – Introduced by Representative Black. Referred to Committee on Small Business and Economic Development.

AN ACT to repeal 134.66 (2) (c) 1. a., 134.66 (2) (c) 1. b., 134.66 (2) (c) 2., 134.66 (2) (c) 3., 134.66 (2) (c) 4., 134.66 (2) (cm) 2. and 134.66 (2) (cm) 3.; and to renumber and amend 134.66 (2) (c) 1. (intro.) and 134.66 (2) (cm) 1. of the statutes; relating to: cigarette vending machines.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no retailer may keep a cigarette vending machine in any public place that is open to persons under the age of 18 unless the vending machine is in plain view and control of an employe, is in a location inaccessible to the public when the premises are closed and is more than 500 feet from a school.

This bill prohibits a retailer from keeping a cigarette vending machine in any public place that is open to persons under the age of 18, without exception.
