Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill names the state office building located at 101 East Wilson Street in the city of Madison "The Ronald Reagan Building". Currently, there is no statutory name for this building. The department of administration, which manages state office buildings, has named the building "The Administration Building".
